

The 2007 conference is being proposed to be in California and as a joint conference with WFPS.


The 2004 conference gave us a profit of \$33,000 as well as NALS profit of \$22,000.

Chapters are being asked to call members in their area that have not yet paid their State membership dues. Our membership is up to 2025 members and rising.


A Subdivision Map Act seminar is currently being planned is San Luis Obispo sometime in September with Mike Durkee as speaker.



Proposed Bylaws Amendment: TERM LIMITS To be voted on by the membership at the September 2004 Business Meeting Published in the August and September Issues of Parallax

ARTICLE 12 AMENDMENT TO BYLAWS states that the Central Coast Chapter bylaws may be amended by two-thirds majority at a chapter meeting with 14 days advance written notice.

Section 6.03 currently reads as follows:

SECTION 6.03 OUALIFICATIONS

Each officer shall be a Chapter and Association member in good standing. The President, Vice-President and Chapter Representatives shall be corporate members of the Association. No member shall serve more than two (2) consecutive terms in the same office.


Section 6.03 is proposed to be amended as follows:

SECTION 6.03 QUALIFICATIONS

Each officer shall be a Chapter and Association member in good standing. The President, Vice-President and Chapter Representatives shall be corporate members of the Association. No member shall serve more than two (2) consecutive terms in the same office.

Each office of President, Vice-President or Secretary/Treasurer shall be filled no more than two consecutive years by any one member.

A \$500 donation was approved to be sent to ACSM/NSPS for a surveying exhibit in the Library of Congress. Each state has been requested to make a similar donation.

Central Office has been directed to explore creation of a Memorandum of Understanding (M.O.U.) that would allow our members to join NSPS at a reduced rate on a sliding scale based on the number of CLSA members participating. The idea being to allow dues to be paid directly to NSPA and avoid Central Office from having to calculate and forward dues payments.


