Legislative Committee:

- AB3176-Monument Rehabilitation, CLSA sponsored. ACEC suggested for his bill to be moved to section B&P 8771.6- <u>Chapter voted in favor</u>
- The language of AB3176 was included in AB 3253 which is a bill already in the sunset review for the next 4 years, starting on January 1, 2025. On January 2029- this bill will either be amended, removed, or become permanent.
- AB2451 (Cervantes): this bill dealt with overlapping classifications regarding surveying and the labor code-DEAD
